

2024 Royalty Contract

Junior, Teen, & Ms. Spanish Festival Queens

- 1. Ages are calculated as of October 5, 2024: Junior must be between the ages of 12-14, Teen must be between the ages of 15-17. Junior & Teen Queens must be single and have never been married, pregnant, nor had a child. Junior & Teen Queens must be of good moral character and never been convicted of any felony and must be a resident of Louisiana.
- 2. Ms. Queen may be married or have a child (18+) or single and over the age of 24. The Ms. Queen must be of good moral character, never been convicted of any felony and must a resident of Louisiana.
- 3. Junior, Teen, & Ms. Spanish Festival Queens must <u>NOT</u> hold any <u>CONTRACTED</u> Festival titles and may <u>NOT</u> enter any other pageants throughout their reign (1 year) as a Spanish Festival Queen.
- 4. Junior, Teen, & Ms. Spanish Festival Queens are invited to travel throughout the state of Louisiana. Junior and Teen Spanish Festival Queens MUST have one parent or adult, over the age of 21 traveling with them always throughout their reign as Spanish Festival Queen.
- 5. In the event, if a Queen accepts an invitation to attend a function, she must always present herself in a lady-like manner. Any bad conduct while representing El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia may result in immediate dismissal. Spanish Festival Queens must be present during the entire event as invite except in cases of illness, death of a family member, or the permission of the inviting director. Spanish Festival Queens are expected to be dressed appropriately. No Jeans or Shorts unless the invitation specifically recommends. NO holy jeans/shorts are to be worn during reign. Queens are not allowed to wear "short/tight fitted" shorts to any events while representing the Spanish Festival. Attire should always be coordinated to compliment with the Spanish Festival colors: red, yellow/gold, black, white, and blue.
- 6. If any of the following rules are broken, the title and all privileges may be revoked immediately and will revert to El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia. The following constitutes bad and inappropriate conduct/behavior:
 - Posting inappropriate posts/photos on social media.
 - No nude or seminude photos
 - Absolutely no photos of you drinking or smoking or the appearance of either, even if you are of drinking age.
 - No photos with males or females that can be portrayed in a sexual nature
 - No vulgar comments left on your social media page as well as no vulgar words posted.
 - All photos and comments not following these guidelines MUST be taken down.

At any time, the festival board reserves the right to discuss with you any content we deem Inappropriate.

- 1. Disrespecting others on social media
- 2. Improper moral conduct or disrespect
- 3. Foul or Abusive language
- 4. Physical violence of any degree
- 5. Vulgar body display or vulgar dancing
- 6. Smoking, drinking of Alcohol while representing El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia.
- 7. Illegal drug use

- 8. Failure to abide by a hosting Festival or Organization rules
- 9. Poor Attitude/Unfriendliness
- 10. Usage of cell phones in a disruptive manner during an event for texting, social media, or talking.
- 11. Engaging in public display of affection (i.e. kissing on lips, sitting on another person's lap, holding hands in public, etc.) with individuals NOT related by blood while representing the New Iberia Spanish Festival. NO photos of the same posted anywhere by anyone at any time while in crown and banner.
- 12. Removal of the crown and banner while attending a festival does **NOT** exempt the queen from her responsibilities
- 7. If any of the above rules are broken, the consequences are at the discretion of the director. Consequences may include but are not limited to removal of title by the Festival Board.
- 8. Junior, Teen, & Ms. Spanish Festival Queens are responsible for the maintenance and carrying her custom crown and banner. If any destruction occurs of the crown or banner the Queen will be responsible for the repair/replacement expenses. ALL items must NOT be left inside a vehicle and must be stored properly in an air-conditioned room.
- 9. Junior, Teen, & Ms. Spanish Festival Queens agree to spend the 11th annual El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia April 11-13, 2025, from Friday to Sunday of the festival weekend by participating in ALL events throughout the festival weekend, including television appearances and interviews. Festival weekend will consist of Queen Day Events, Opening Ceremony, Royalty Presentations, Running of the Bulls, Cook-Off & Car Show Awards, Parade, Genealogy Displays, Thanksgiving Mass, and to Thank all vendors for attending.
- 10. Junior, Teen, & Ms. Spanish Festival Queens are required to attend the Annual Spanish King's Ball/Poster unveiling on Friday, October 3, 2025.
- 11. Junior, Teen, & Ms. Spanish Festival Queens are expected to attend a minimum of (12) LAFF Festivals/Pageant events throughout their reign, (3+) per quarter. Junior, Teen, & Ms. Spanish Festival Queens are required to send a quarterly report with travel appearances to the director after each quarter to spanishfestivalpageants@gmail.com

1st Qtr. | October - December 31st 2nd Qtr. | January - March 31st 3rd Qtr. | April - June 30th

4th Qtr. | July - Thursday of Pageant week

- 12. Ms. Spanish Festival Queen is invited (not required) to attend the Louisiana Association of Fairs and Festivals Convention on February 6-9, 2025, in Baton Rouge at the Crowne Plaza Hotel. Activities throughout the convention include Thursday night-Taste of Louisiana, workshops, trade shows, Friday night Showcase, Saturday night Banquet, and Sunday breakfast. Ms. Spanish Festival Queen will be responsible for their weekend hotel stay and expenses.
- 13. Spanish Festival Queens are required to attend New Iberia events where she is invited to, including but not limited: LA. Sugar Cane Festival, Gumbo Cook-Off, Halloween Parade, Spanish Festival Christmas Party, Mardi Gras Parade, Live Oak Festival, Christmas Parade. We also encourage all Queens to take part in volunteering/community service work throughout their reign as a Spanish Queen such as volunteering at local festivals and events or collecting donations for our very own "Bless a Resident" donation drive for Nursing/Assisted Living Homes in New Iberia.
- 14. Removal of the crown and banner while attending a festival does not exempt the queen from her responsibilities. If any Queen feels that she cannot complete her (1) year required duties representing El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia, please inform Pageant Director immediately. Remember as a Festival Queen, with or without your crown and banner you are a role model, ambassador and spokesperson and should always treat everyone with kindness and respect while conducting yourself with dignity and integrity and should always have a positive perspective.
- 15. Junior, Teen, & Ms. Spanish Festival Queens agree to allow El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia to use information and photographs to promote the festival. Spanish Festival Queens agrees El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia, La Association de Nueva Iberia, and pageant director are not responsible for loss of personal belongings, accidents, or illnesses during her travels.
- 16. Junior, Teen, & Ms. Spanish Festival Queens and Parent/Guardian are required to sign contracts immediately following the Queen's Pageant. A Parent or guardian must be present with the newly crowned Queen. All rules and regulations will be reviewed. If the newly crowned Ms. Queen is interested in attending the LAFF convention held February 6-9, 2025, in Baton Rouge, LA, money will be collected at the contract signing. Packets for the weekend are \$170 per person and does not include hotel stay. This fun filled weekend is not mandatory but highly recommended! Delegates must be 18 and over to attend the convention.
