



2026 Spanish Festival Queens Contract Deb Miss, Junior and Teen

1. Ages are calculated as of October 4, 2026: Deb Miss must be between the ages of 9 - 11, Junior must be between the ages of 12 - 14, Teen must be between the ages of 15 - 17, must be single, never married, pregnant, nor had a child and must be of good moral character and never been convicted of any felony. Deb Miss, Junior and Teen must be a resident of Louisiana and compete as same sex you were born.
2. Deb Miss, Junior, and Teen Spanish Festival Queen must **NOT** hold **ANY Contracted** Festival titles and may **NOT** enter any other pageants throughout their reign (1 year) as a Spanish Festival Queen.
3. Deb Miss, Junior and Teen Spanish Festival Queen are required to travel throughout the state of Louisiana. You **MUST** have one parent or adult, over the age of 21 traveling with you at all times throughout your reign as Spanish Festival Queen.
4. A chaperone **MUST** be present at all times if you are attending any event or sleepover; the chaperone must be over 21 years of age and must **NOT** be of the opposite sex.
5. **NO** chaperone of the opposite sex; unless it's a parent or guardian.
6. A chaperone can **NOT** be a significant other regardless of gender.
7. Anytime you must travel overnight and/or out of town, you **MUST** have a parent or guardian with you. **NO** person, not related by blood is allowed to travel with the Queens without a parent or guardian.
8. In the event YOU accept an invitation to attend a function, YOU must always present yourself in a lady-like and proper manner. Any bad sportmanship/conduct while representing El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia will require an immediate dismissal. YOU must be present during the entire event as invited, except in cases of illness, death of family member or the permission of the inviting director.
9. If YOU formally accept an invitation and YOU are no longer able to attend, then **YOU MUST** inform your Director and Inviting Queen.
10. Deb Miss, Junior and Teen Festival Queens are expected to dress appropriately. **NO** Jeans or Shorts unless the invitation specifically states and **NO** holy jeans/shorts are to be worn anytime during reign.
11. If you are allowed to wear jeans or shorts they must **NOT** be short/tight fitted to any event while representing the Spanish Festival. (Use the fingertip method)
12. Dresses are to be of appropriate length. (Use the fingertip method)
13. Attire should always be coordinated to compliment with the Spanish Festival colors: red, yellow/gold, black, white, blue and green.

14. If ANY of the following rules are broken, the consequences are at the discretion of the director.

The title and all privileges may be revoked immediately and may revert back to El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia and it is the Festival Board who reserves the right to discuss with you any content we deem inappropriate. Consequences may include but are not limited to removal of title once discussion is complete. The following constitutes inappropriate conduct/behavior:

- a. Posting inappropriate posts/photos on social media
 - b. No nude or seminude photos posted or shared
 - c. **ABSOLUTELY NO** photos of you drinking or smoking/vaping or the appearance of either
 - d. **ABSOLUTELY NO** drinking or smoking/vaping
 - e. **NO** photos with males or females that can be portrayed in a sexual nature
 - f. **NO** vulgar comments left on your social media pages as well as **NO** vulgar words posted
 - g. **ANY and ALL** photos comments not following these guidelines **MUST** be taken down **IMMEDIATELY**
 - h. **NO** Disrespecting others on social media
 - i. **NO** improper moral conduct or disrespect
 - j. **NO** foul or abusive language at anytime or on social media
 - k. **NO** physical violence of any degree
 - l. **NO** vulgar body display or vulgar dancing
 - m. **NO** use of Illegal drugs of any kind
 - n. Poor Attitude or unfriendliness conduct anytime or on social media
 - o. Engaging in public displaying of affection (ie. kissing on lips, sitting on another person's lap of the opposite sex, holding hands in public, etc.) with individuals **NOT** related by blood while representing the New Iberia Spanish Festival.
 - p. **NO** photos of the same as above shall be posted by anyone at any time while crown and banner are on
 - q. Usage of cell phones in a disruptive manner during an event for texting, social media or talking is prohibited
 - r. Removal of crown and/or banner while attending a festival does **NOT** exempt you from your responsibilities
15. Deb Miss, Junior and Teen Spanish Festival Queen are responsible for the maintenance and care of her custom crown and banner. If any destruction occurs on any of the above mentioned items the Deb Miss, Junior and Teen Queen **WILL BE** responsible for the expenses.
16. ALL items must **NOT** be left inside a vehicle at **ANY TIME** and must be stored properly in an air conditioned room.
17. Deb Miss, Junior and Teen Spanish Festival Queen are **REQUIRED** to attend the **ETIQUETTE TRAINING CLASS - Sunday, October 25, 1pm - 2 pm**

18. Deb Miss, Junior and Teen Spanish Festival Queen are **REQUIRED** to attend the City of New Iberia events where she is invited to, including but not limited to: Gumbo Cook-Off, Halloween Parade, Spanish Festival Christmas Party, Christmas Parade, Festival of Live Oaks, Mardi Gras Parade, Remembering Francisco Bouligny (Labor Day) and LA Sugar Cane Festival.
19. We also encourage our Queen to take part in volunteering/community service work throughout her reign such as volunteering at local festivals and events or collecting donations for our very own "Bless a Resident" donation drive.
20. Deb Miss, Junior and Teen Spanish Festival Queen agrees to allow El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia to use their information and photographs to promote the festival. She also agrees to NOT hold El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia, LA Association de Nueva Iberia and pageant director or anyone affiliated responsible for loss of personal belongings, accidents or illness during her travels.
21. Deb Miss, Junior and Teen Spanish Festival Queen agrees to spend the weekend at the 13th Annual El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia on April 16 - 18, 2027, by participating in **ALL** events throughout the Festival weekend, including: Television appearances and interviews, Thanksgiving Mass and Blessing of the Crochet Ceiling down Church Alley, Opening Ceremonies, Royalty Introduction, Parade, Running of the Bulls Race, Cook-Off & Car Show Awards, Genealogy displays, Queen's Day Activities, going around festival to thank all vendors, cooks and guests for attending and more.
22. Deb Miss, Junior and Teen Spanish Festival Queen are **REQUIRED** to participate in the Annual Spanish Festival King's Ball/Poster Unveiling on Saturday, October 2, 2027.
23. Deb Miss is **EXPECTED** to attend a minimum of (6) LAFF Festivals/Pageant events throughout her reign.
24. Junior and Teen Spanish Festival Queens are **EXPECTED** to attend a minimum of (12) LAFF Festivals/Pageant events throughout her reign (3+) per quarter.
25. Deb Miss, Junior and Teen Spanish Festival Queens are also required to send a quarterly report at the end of each quarter with travel appearances to the director at:

27. If you feel you cannot complete your (1) year required duties representing El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia, please inform us ASAP!

28. REMEMBER as a Festival Queen, with or without your crown and banner YOU are a role model, ambassador and spokesperson and should always treat everyone with kindness and respect while conducting yourself with dignity and integrity and should always have a positive perspective.

29. The newly crowned Deb Miss, Junior and Teen Spanish Festival Queens are REQUIRED to sign their contract and take pictures immediately following the Queen's Pageant. A Parent or guardian MUST be present with the newly crowned Queen. All rules and regulations will be reviewed and a copy will be provided of the contract once signed.

30. If any of the above rules are broken, the consequences are at the discretion of the director. Consequences may include but are not limited to removal of title upon the Festival Board.
